It is suitable for children from ages 6 thru 14, no experience or equipment is required. Low student / instructor ratio, minimum of 6 students required for class to go ahead.

### **“CN Future Links” Level 2 & Level 3**

Level 3 refines their skills and enhances their increasing knowledge base about the game and their golf swing. Minimum 6 students per session required for Levels 2 & 3.
